WANT TO REDUCE YOUR TAX LIABILITY?

The Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP)

-program through the Commonwealth of Virginia/Department of Social Services

What is NAP?

- The purpose of the Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP) is to encourage businesses, trusts, and individuals to make donations to approved 501(c) (3) organizations for the benefit of low-income persons. (Brock Hughes Medical Center is an approved NAP organization.)
- In return for their contributions, businesses, trusts, and individuals may receive state tax credits equal to **65 percent of the donation** that may be applied against their state income tax liability!!!
- The minimum contribution for individuals is **\$500.00**; the minimum contribution for businesses is **\$616.00**.

The Process:

1. Individual/Business makes a contribution to the approved NAP organization:
 - Brock Hughes Free Clinic, Inc.
2. Executive Director (ED) of BHFC completes the application
3. Donor signs the application
4. ED submits the application electronically with supporting documents
 - (proof of donation, ex. Copy of check)
5. Donor will then receive a certificate from the NAP program that will be submitted when filing state taxes

The Cycle:

July 1st-June 30th of each year

It's a Win-Win for the Donor and the Organization!
